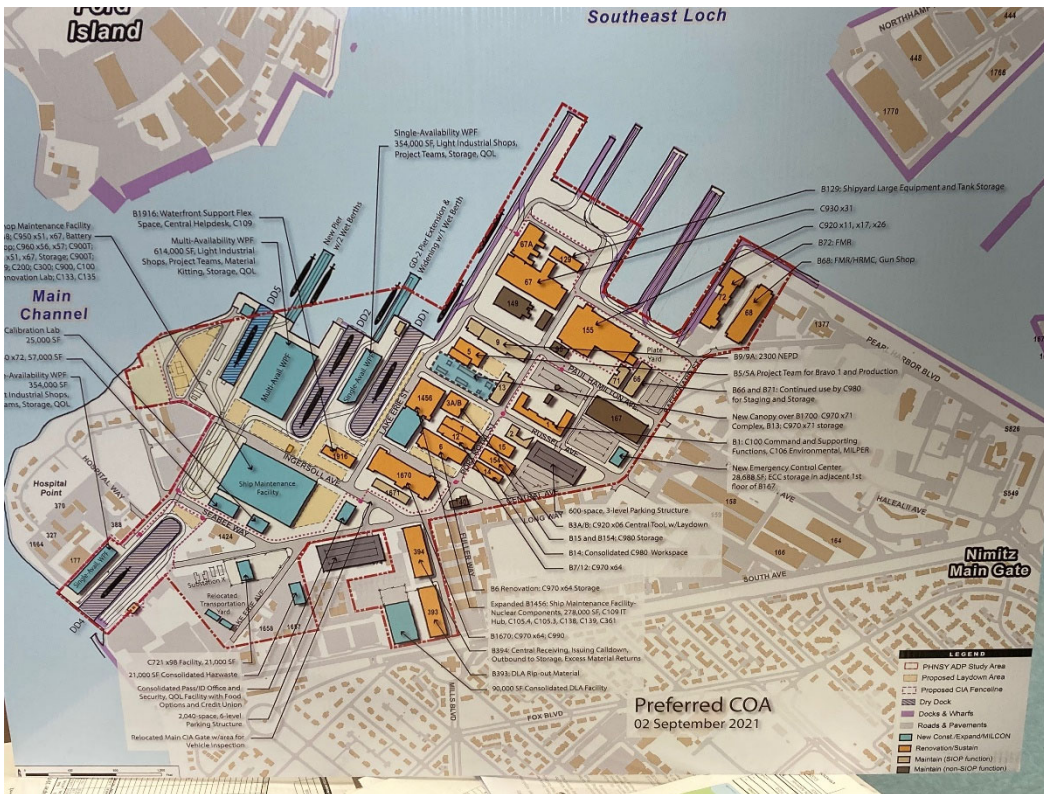

April's Speaker was Chad Nakamoto (pictured on right), Code 900F, who spoke about DD#5 and conceptual planning for the future. In addition to the new Drydock Project - P-209, the shipyard is considering the following: Multi-project Waterfront Support Facility (WSF) over the old DD#3 location, 2 new multilevel parking structures close to the access gates, replacing Bldg 214/214A with a new Maintenance facility and relocating SY Command back to Bldg 1. Construction for DD#5 will be challenging while keeping the fleet supported. Construction crews will ferry in via Ford Island and material staging will come from the Waipio Peninsula. While funding for P-209, DD#5 is firmly in place, still under discussion is funding for the WSF. Our support may be needed in the exciting times to come.
