
FMA CHAPTER 19 NEWS

April's Speaker was Chad Nakamoto (pictured on right), Code 900F, who spoke about the proposed Dry Dock 3 replacement project (proposed Dry Dock 5) and conceptual planning for the future. In addition to the new Dry Dock project – P-209, the Shipyard is considering the following: a waterfront production facility near Dry Dock 5 and other facilities along the waterfront. Construction for Dry Dock 5 will be challenging while

keeping the fleet supported. Construction crews may ferry in via Ford Island and material staging could come from Waipio Peninsula. Our support may be needed in the exciting times to come.
